Request for Board Consideration:

The Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area is requesting that the Board accept the late filed Annual Certificate filed on May 3, 2013 for the fiscal years 2004 - 2012. The Annual Certificates were signed by the Fire Chief and notarized. Included was the training documentation by fiscal year as is required. See details below.

Correspondence:

August 1, 2003 - Sent a letter for the fire chief requesting documentation of the department's qualified status.

January 5, 2007 – Sent a letter to Fire Chief Nickie Cayko, informing him of missing annual certificates for fiscal years 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and again requesting the documentation of the department's qualified status.

August 14, 2007 – Letter sent to acting Fire Chief Jeff Brock with 2007 annual certificate after his request that the Annual Certificate be sent to him. Also, the June 30, 2007 letter that accompanies the Annual Certificate was sent at this time.

August 27, 2007 – Received FY2007 notarized annual certificate from Jeff Brock.

August 28, 2007 – Letter sent to Jeff Brock requesting documentation of the department's qualified status.

April 21, 2009 – Letter sent to Training Officer Todd Schmidt, informing him of missing annual certificates for fiscal years 2003, 2004, 2005/2006/2007 and 2008 and requesting the documentation of the departments qualified status.

May 15, 2009 – Received Anaconda-Deer Lodge county commission minutes, interlocal agreement, a map of serviced area, population, documentation of unincorporated area, asset valuation, name and mailing address, and list of officers.

June 4, 2009 – Letter sent to Todd Schmidt requesting information about name discrepancies and the commissioner meeting minutes establishing the Georgetown Lake VFD before name change to Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area.

June 29, 2009 – Letter received from S.L. Sayatovia, EMS coordinator, with information requested about name change of VFD.

December 3, 2012 – Letter received from acting Fire Chief Bart Bonney, detailing information regarding the Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area. The letter states that Georgetown Lake VFD was not a registered fire department with Deer Lodge County between 1975 and 1998. On April 4, 1998, Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area was formed with the proper documentation with the Deer Lodge County Commission. The letter also states that Fire Chief Bonney is aware that only the 3 previous years would be eligible to receive

credit, based on statute. Fire Chief Bonney also requested to appeal the other years to the board.

April 1, 2013 – Letter sent to Acting Fire Chief Bart Bonney in response to his December 3, 2012 letter to MPERA. Enclosed with this letter was the VFCA Annual Certificates for the following fiscal years: FY2002-2003, FY2003-2004, FY2004-2005, FY2005-2006, FY2006-2007, FY2007-2008, FY2008-2009, FY2010-2011, and FY2011-2012. MPERA staff addressed in the letter, that only annual certificates filed within 3 years of the original due date would be considered for amendment.

Copies of already submitted annual certificates FY1998-1999, FY1999-2000, FY2000-2001 were also sent. No training documentation was sent with FY1999 and FY2000; for FY2001 an incomplete training record was sent.

May 3, 2013 – Received letter of explanation from Fire Chief Bonney; notarized annual certificates for fiscal years 2003 through 2012; and training documentation.

May 10, 2013 – Letter received from Fire Chief Bonney certifying all training documentation.

March 18, 2014 – Letter sent to Fire Chief Bonney requesting additional information about annual certificates and training documentation.

May 1, 2014 – Fire Chief Bonney came to MPERA and discussed with Ali Sturm, information that was needed. He delivered training information and new annual certificates for FY2010 – FY2012.

June 11, 2014 – Received a letter from Fire Chief Bonney requesting to speak to the board during the informal consideration.

August 6, 2014 – Email sent to Fire Chief Bonney requesting revised Annual Certificates for members who had received training hours and informing him that the Annual Certificate could not be amended again.

August 6, 2014 – Email received from Fire Chief Bonney stating the members in question were no longer members of the Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area and had not been for a period of time.

Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area

Acceptance of past Certificates that increase members' years of service

Summary:

Pursuant to § 19-17-112 (5), MCA a late filed certificate must be filed within 3 years of the due date. The information for the FY1999 - FY2012 Annual Certificates was received on April 29, 2013. Therefore, the only Annual Certificates that can be considered for late filings are: FY2008-2009; FY2009-2010; FY2010-2011; and FY2011-2012.

RELEVANT LAW AND RULES:

Montana Code Annotated (Effective before July 1, 2011)

19-17-108. Credit for service as volunteer firefighter – records. (1) The annual period of service that may be credited under this chapter is the fiscal year. A fractional part of a year may not count toward the service required for participation in this system. To be eligible to receive credit for any particular year, a volunteer firefighter shall serve with a fire company throughout the entire fiscal year.

(2) The years of service are cumulative and need not be continuous. Separate periods of service properly credited with different fire companies must be credited toward a member's eligibility for full or partial benefits.

(3) A volunteer firefighter must receive credit for service during any fiscal year if:

(a) during the fiscal year, the volunteer firefighter completes a minimum of 30 hours of training in matters pertaining to firefighting under a formal program that has been formulated, supervised, and certified to the board by the chief or designated official of the fire company;

(b) the volunteer firefighter's participation in the training program is documented in the fire company's records filed and maintained by the chief or designated official; and

(c) the fire company maintained firefighting equipment that is in serviceable condition and owns, rents, or uses one or more buildings used for the storage of that equipment that all together are valued at \$12,000 or more.

(4) The chief or designated official of each fire company shall keep and maintain training records for each current and former volunteer firefighter who is or was a member of the fire company.

Montana Code Annotated (Effective July 1, 2011)

19-17-108. Credit for service as a volunteer firefighter – records. (1) The annual period of service that may be credited under this chapter is the fiscal year. A fractional part of a year may not count toward the service required for participation in this system. To be eligible to receive credit for any particular year, a volunteer firefighter shall serve throughout the entire fiscal year with a single fire company that is organized under Title 7, chapter 33, and continues to meet the requirements of 19-17-109.

(2) The years of service are cumulative and need not be continuous. Separate periods of service properly credited with different fire companies must be credited toward a member's eligibility for benefits.

(3) A volunteer firefighter may not receive credit for service during any fiscal year unless:

(a) during the fiscal year, the volunteer firefighter completes a minimum of 30 hours of training in firefighting duties as outlined in 19-17-105 under a formal program that has been formulated, supervised, and certified to the board by the chief or designated official of the fire company; and

(b) the volunteer firefighter's participation in the training program is documented in the fire company's records maintained pursuant to 19-17-111 by the chief or designated official.

Montana Code Annotated (Effective July 1, 2011)

19-17-112. Filing required reports – limitations. (1) The chief or designated official of each fire company that claims eligibility under this chapter shall, on or before September 1 of each year, file with the board an annual certificate, the current year's roster, and a membership card for each new member.

(2) (a) The annual certificate is a form reporting a fire company's membership eligibility for the previous fiscal year.

(b) The annual certificate must be completed on a form prescribed by the board and contain the date of organization of the fire company and the full name, social security number, and date of birth of each member of the fire company who was a member for the entire fiscal year and who successfully completed 30 hours of training during the preceding fiscal year, as required by 19-17-108.

(c) The chief or designated official shall subscribe and verify under oath, before a notary, that the fire company and members qualified under 19-17-108 and 19-17-109.

(d) The board shall maintain the certificate for the purpose of establishing service for members and eligibility for benefits.

(3) The roster must be signed by the fire chief or designated official, filed with the board, and contain information in writing that provides the names of the fire company, its date of organization, officers, and roll of active and inactive members for the current fiscal year. A roster may be updated to report new members but may not be retroactive.

(4) A membership card must be completed and filed with the board for each member who was a member on or before July 1, 2011, and for each new member who joins after July 1, 2011.

(5) The current fire chief shall file any late or amended annual certificates and the associated certified training records within 3 years of the original annual certificate due date. An annual certificate may be amended only once. The board shall consider and may approve late filings. Information provided to the board by the fire chief must be in accordance with the board's rules.

(6) The current fire chief may request to appear before the board for consideration of the request to file a late or amended annual certificate.

Montana Code Annotated (Effective before July 1, 2011. Repealed in 2011 Legislature and added to 19-17-112, MCA)

19-17-402. Certificate of eligibility. The chief or designated official of each fire company that claims eligibility under this chapter shall, on or before September 1 of each year, file a certificate on a form to be provided by the board, subscribed and verified under oath before a notary, stating whether the company qualified under [19-17-108](#)(3) during the preceding fiscal year. The certificate must contain the date of organization. The certificate must list the full name, social security number, and date of birth of each member of the fire company who was a member for the entire fiscal year and satisfactorily completed 30 hours of training during the preceding fiscal year, as required by [19-17-108](#)(3). The certificate must be maintained by the board for the purpose of establishing service for members and eligibility for benefits.

MPERA ARM

2.43.5001 BASIC UNIT OF SERVICE (1) As of July 1, 1965, the basic unit of service for volunteer firefighters is one fiscal year. Volunteer firefighters not continuously on the active membership list of a single qualifying volunteer fire company for the entire fiscal year shall not be listed on the annual certificate and shall not receive credit for service under the Volunteer Firefighters' Compensation Act (VFCA) for that fiscal year. A volunteer fire company qualifies to participate in the VFCA if the requirements of 19-17-402, MCA, are met.

(2) A volunteer firefighter shall receive one year of credit for service under the VFCA for each two full fiscal years of service performed prior to July 1, 1965. (History: 19-17-203, MCA; IMP, 19-17-201, 19-17-401, 19-17-402, MCA; NEW, 1986 MAR p. 1454, Eff. 8/29/86; AMD, 2003 MAR p. 1188, Eff. 6/13/03; AMD & TRANS, from ARM 2.43.801, 2008 MAR p. 2467, Eff. 12/01/08.)

2.43.5002 FAILURE TO FILE REQUIRED REPORTS (1) In order to receive credit for service under the VFCA, volunteer fire companies must file an "annual certificate" with MPERA. The certification is a report by the fire chief that the members listed on the certificate were active for the full fiscal year and also had the required 30 hours of training. This report is on a fiscal year basis (July through June) and is due by September 1 of each year. The annual certificate is signed by the fire chief and notarized. Annual certificate forms are provided by MPERA.

(2) Annual certificates filed after the September 1 due date must be appealed to and considered by the board for approval. Information provided to the board by the fire chief or designated official must include:

- (a) the original, notarized annual certificate;
- (b) certified training documents showing the required 30 hours of training per listed member;
- (c) a letter from the fire chief explaining why the annual certificate was not filed timely; and
- (d) if requested by the fire chief, oral argument before board. (History: 19-17-203, MCA; IMP, 19-17-201, 19-17-402, MCA; NEW, 1986 MAR p. 1454, Eff. 8/29/86; AMD, 2003 MAR p. 1188, Eff. 6/13/03; AMD & TRANS, from ARM 2.43.802, 2008 MAR p. 2467, Eff. 12/01/08.)

Once the documentation above is received by the Public Employees' Retirement Board, it will be reviewed for completeness. Before supplemental payments are made it will be verified that these requirements have been submitted.

1. Georgetown Lake VFD was not a registered fire department with Deer Lodge County Commission between 1975 and 1998, no tax dollars supported its existence. During this period of time it was just a bunch of guys that had a couple of trucks. To support the operation of this department, fund raising events were scheduled 2 to 3 time a year. During this period of time we had no ISO rating AND no insurance company recognized us as a fire protection unit.
2. In 1997 when we completed the public meetings and petition process for our Fire Service Area, we presented it to the Deer Lodge County Commission and on April 4, 1998 our request was adopted and the Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area was formed, your file has this document. Since 1998 our Fire Service Area has been supported with property tax dollars from Deer Lodge and Granite County's and our current ISO rating is 9. Through our training program we hope to improve our ISO rating this next year.

As we discussed on November 14th, you indicated you would send Annual Certificate Forms for the years we have missing which I believe is 2002 to 2012. And you would give us credit for this year and 3 years previous. For those years you can't give us

credit, I would like to appeal to the Retirement Board. I would like your assistance in getting this process started, if that's a doable deal. Anything else you can think of that may help us with our paper work and staying current would be appreciated.

Dear Acting Fire Chief Bonney,

This letter is in response to the receipt, on December 2, 2012 via e-mail, of the last piece of necessary documentation in order for the Georgetown Lake Fire Service Area to again become a qualified volunteer department under the Volunteer Firefighters' Compensation Act (VFCA).

The PERB has decided that late or amended certificates, when filed properly, accompanied by a letter of explanation from the fire chief, and certified training documentation for the 30 or more hours of training, will be considered for acceptance. Beginning July 1, 2011, only late Annual Certificates that are filed within 3 years of the original Annual Certificate due date will be considered. The due dates of annual certificates are September 1 of each year for the previous fiscal year (ie FY2007-2008 was due September 1, 2008). An annual certificate may be amended only once.

The certified training information must be based on fiscal years (July 1st thru June 30th) and in an easily readable format. Training documentation must include the following:

- ❖ The date the training was offered;
- ❖ Title of the training;
- ❖ Description of the training;
- ❖ Hours of training;
- ❖ Each member's hours of training for each class.

Training does not include business meetings, emergency calls or vehicle or hall maintenance.

Enclosed you will find VFCA Annual Certificates for FY2002-2003, FY2003-2004, FY2004-2005, FY2005-2006, FY2006-2007, FY2007-2008, FY2008-2009, FY2009-2010, FY2010-2011, and FY2011-2012. On the enclosed annual certificates, please include names of all members that qualified for credit that fiscal year. Don't forget to fill in all information (SSN, Birthdate, VFCA Entry Date, and a Y or N in the Credit Column) for each member listed or they will not receive credit.

Return the original, notarized annual certificates along with the certified training records corresponding to the fiscal years that are being late filed. Faxes and/or copies of the annual certificates will not be accepted. Remember that an annual certificate may be amended only once.

Note: Past years of credited service are a consideration of the Public Employees' Board (PERB) and are not a guarantee that a year of credited service for your members will be granted; especially if those years are not within the 3 years of the original Annual Certificate due date of September 1.


The late Annual Certificates, certified training records, and letter of explanation must be received within 90 days of the date of this letter in order for your request to be considered.

Also send in a separate roster (listing) of all the members for the current fiscal year 2012-2013, whether they received credit or not they need to be listed. This listing must have the address of the fire company and the date that the fire company was established. The roster no longer needs to be certified with the County Clerk.
