TITLE: FLO-Charge for Excessive Use of Staff Time

POLICY NO: BOARD Op 03 EFFECTIVE DATE: 06/09/2016

I. POLICY AND OBJECTIVES

The Public Employees' Retirement Board (the Board) desires to provide information relevant to drafting Family Law Orders (FLOs) at no charge to members and their attorneys. However, the Board discourages excessive use of staff, resulting in excess cost to the retirement systems. Therefore, the member or the member's attorney will be charged for excessive (over 8 hours) use of staff hours in drafting a FLO.

II. APPLICABILITY

- A. This policy will apply to exceeding 8 hours time spent reviewing and processing a draft FLO and providing written or oral responses to questions. The Montana Public Employee Retirement Administration (MPERA) will apply this policy whether or not the draft FLO is approved.
- B. This policy does not apply to implementing an approved FLO or to providing general information about the FLO process.

III. PROCEDURES

- A. The MPERA will track the number of hours legal staff devote to each draft FLO.
- B. The MPERA will not charge for the first 8 hours of staff time devoted to a draft FLO. The MPERA will charge \$35 per hour for each hour in excess of 8 hours.
- C. The MPERA will have the discretion to waive charges for processing the draft FLO if the Executive Director decides the excessive use of staff time was unavoidable.
