## VI.B. Legislative Tracking

- Member Rich Hickel moved that the Board be a proponent on LC2376, a legislative concept to generally revise state finance laws. Member Terry Halpin seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- Member Jason Strouf moved that the Board be a proponent on SB 208 (formerly LC1064), a bill to revise the definition of "dependent child" in HPORS, MPORS and FURS. Member Doug Kary seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
