

## FIREFIGHTERS' UNIFIED RETIREMENT SYSTEM (FURS) OPTIONAL MEMBERSHIP ELECTION FOR PART- PAID FIREFIGHTERS

This election is only for a firefighter who is not already a member or retiree of FURS.

You became a part-paid firefighter once you earned over \$300 in a fiscal year. You now have the option to elect to join FURS. You must make this election within 90 days of becoming a part-paid firefighter.			
If you elect FURS membership, you and your employer must make statutorily required contributions to FURS.			
If you decline FURS membership you cannot:			
<ul> <li>become a member while still employed as a part-paid firefighter;</li> <li>receive membership service credit or service credit for employment for which membership was declined;</li> <li>be considered an active, inactive or retired member of FURS.</li> <li>In the future, if you accept employment as a full-time firefighter, FURS membership is mandatory, and you must become a member regardless of this election.</li> </ul>
